Modified wrestling begins January 3rd. It is still not too late to sign up. Any 7th or 8th grader interested in wrestling go to nurses office and sign up.

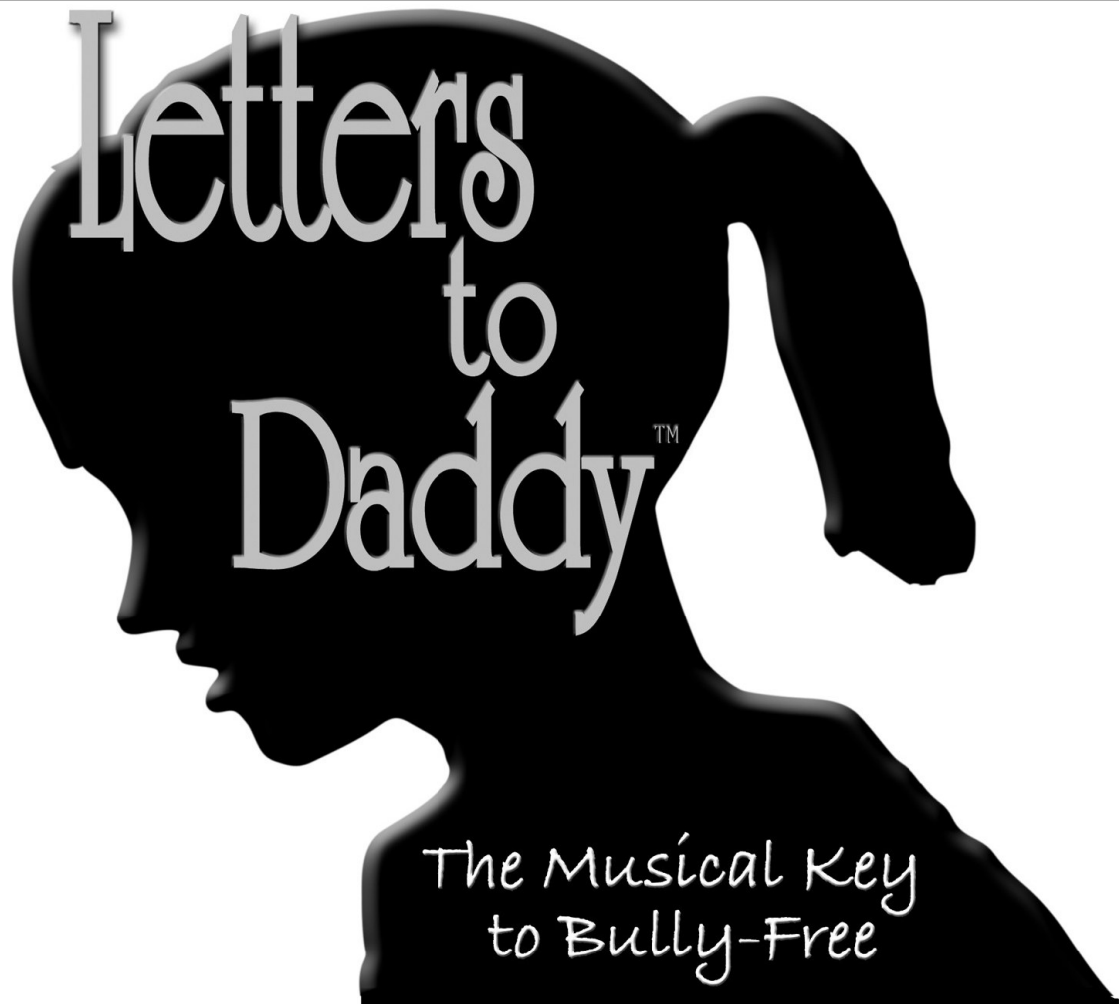
Youth Wrestling registration begins January 4th

Students are not allowed to carry any prescription or over the counter drugs in school. This includes Tylenol and Ibuprofen. All medicine must be brought to the Nurse's office and distributed from there. Students tend to share medication and don't know if others have allergies or sensitivities to simple over the counter medications, and this could cause medical emergencies! I am happy to give out medication as needed with Doctor and parent permission in writing.
